While repairs had kept this pool operating for several years immediately after the earthquake, the leaking was finally judged as beyond further repair. Work to design a new pool facility, which began in late 2002, is 75% complete, and led to a recent announcement of funding to demolish the old structure and construct a new family Aquatic Center and Bathhouse Building. Completion of design, then the bidding process and construction, will take about eighteen months, with opening by the 2006 summer season. Estimated cost: \$6 million



Recreation and Parks Facility Repair Division recently converted this seasonal pool to a year-round pool at a cost of \$1.3 million. The work included enclosing two locker rooms with a new roof, rebuilding restrooms and shower area, and upgrading the facility for ADA compliance. The Department replaced the hot and cold water lines and installed a new sewer line; replaced the electrical system in the facility; replaced the pumps and filters; installed a new pool heater and gas lines. The Facility Repair Division replaced the entire pool deck, and the parking lot and facility lighting; they installed new concrete floors and surfaces in the building, and installed new windows throughout. The Department installed a forced air heater in the building and painted the entire facility, inside and outside.




