### **Special Issues**

The seasonal pools in this Council District are in poor condition, with 109<sup>th</sup> Street and Harbor the #7 and #8 priority for pool replacement city-wide, and Gaffey closed since 1989 and needing relocation as well as replacement. Peck Park was successfully converted by Recreation and Parks Facility Repair from a seasonal to a year round pool in 2003.
