

SUBJECT: IN-KIND DONATION TO THE WONDERFUL OUTDOOR WORLD TOURNAMENT OF ROSES PARTICIPATION PROGRAM



RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board accept with gratitude, the in-kind donation of \$2,808 from Mr. George Chatigny, Vice President of the Los Angeles Equestrian Center, for the Wonderful Outdoor World (WOW) camping program in the 2007 Tournament of Roses Parade, as described in the summary of this report.

SUMMARY:

The Camping Division received a donation of \$2,808 in services from the Los Angeles Equestrian Center for the Wonderful Outdoor World (WOW) camping program. The Los Angeles Equestrian Center boarded twenty-six mules and horses that participated in WOW's 2007 Tournament of Roses Parade equestrian entry. The mules and horses ridden by WOW's Rose Parade participants were provided by Red Meadows of Mammoth Lakes, California, and were boarded at the Los Angeles Equestrian Center between December 27, 2006, and January 1, 2007.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT:

The donation has no direct impact on the General Fund; however, it does save the Camping Division \$2,808 in funds from the 301/88-4800 MRP 712 account that would have paid for the boarding of the mules and horses for this program.
