RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board:

- 1. Adopt the Fiscal Year 2008-09 Personnel Resolution, on file in the Board Office, effective July 1, 2008; and,
- 2. Authorize the release of substitute positions for Fiscal Year 2008-09 as listed in the Fiscal Year 2008-09 Personnel Resolution.

SUMMARY:

The Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners establishes the Department's employment authority on an annual basis through the Personnel Resolution.

The Fiscal Year (FY) 2008-09 Personnel Resolution authorizes 2,038 regular positions, five Commissioner positions, 46 substitute positions, 124 special funded (grants and other funding sources) positions, and 48 in-lieu positions. In addition, it authorizes 55 positions subject to renewal on an annual basis ("One-time Positions"). Finally, it authorizes 30 classifications (some at multiple pay grades or salary rates) that may be used to employ as-needed employees, and 23 classifications (some at multiple pay grades or salary rates) that may be used to retain hiring hall craft employees.

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A comparison between positions that were authorized at the outset of FY 2007-08 and those positions that will be authorized for FY 2008-09 is as follows:
