Hiring Hall staff is occasionally utilized during on overtime basis in order to complete high priority projects to ensure the safe and sanitary conditions of park facilities. Additionally, the salaries and rates per hour for Hiring Hall Benefits have risen which has caused and increased liability for the Department. Funds are available from the Salaries General Account (Account 1010).
