GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORTS

CULVER SLAUSON RECREATION CENTER - PHASE II (YOUTH COMMUNITY CENTER) (PRJ20550) (W.O. #E1907289) PROJECT - REVIEW OF BIDS AND AWARD OF CONTRACT

The item was described and presented to the Board by Department staff. Public comments were invited, however, no requests for public comment were received. A detailed discussion by the Commission ensued.

Michael Shull, Superintendent, Planning, Construction and Maintenance Division, requested that the report be amended to include the following language on Page 4, line 7, of the report:

"The game court lighting, consisting of six (6) poles with metal halide fixtures, is a potential environmental issue since the game courts are proposed to be relocated to the midnortherly perimeter of the recreation center near residential properties. To avoid any nuisance spillover lighting from affecting the residences, the fixtures will be properly shielded and angled downward. The lights will also have individual power switches so they can be easily turned off when not in use. These measures will enable the game court lighting to be in compliance with Chapter 9, Section 93.0117 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code, which requires that the illumination at the property line not exceed two (2) footcandles."

Motion

It was moved by Vice President Alvarez, seconded by Commissioner Stanley, that the amendment to General Manager's Report No. 11-281 be approved. The motion carried unanimously.
