RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Accept work performed by Axiom Group (Axiom) under Contract No. 3568 for the Evergreen Recreation Center (AKA Evergreen Park) ADA Facility Improvements (W.O. #E170382F) Project, as outlined in the Summary of this Report; and,
- 2. Authorize the Board Secretary to furnish Axiom Group, with a letter of completion.

SUMMARY

On January 18, 2017, (Report No. 17-011) the construction contract for the Evergreen Recreation Center (AKA Evergreen Park) - Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Facility Improvements (W.O. #E170382F) Project (Project) was awarded to Axiom Group, in the amount of One Hundred Ninety-Two Thousand, Four Hundred Eighty-Eight Dollars (\$192,488.00). The project is located at 2844 East 2nd Street, Los Angeles, California, 90033. This park serves Census Tract 204110, 204120, 204200 and 204420. The recreation center serves approximately 997 youth annually through its co-ed organized basketball, baseball, girls softball and soccer leagues; preschool; afterschool club; and summer day camp.

This Project is a Proposition K Competitive 8th cycle grant funded project. The Department of Public Works, Bureau of Engineering (BOE), Architectural Division prepared the plans and specifications to renovate existing men and women's restrooms to meet the current ADA code requirements. The scope of work includes some demolition and replacement of toilet stalls, sinks, handrails and other necessary

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restroom fixtures, with ADA compliant fixtures, which include electrically operated handdriers and, new electrical outlets. The renovation will also include the construction of a new concrete floor, installation of new wall tiles and installation of new entry doors equipped with electrically controlled security devices.

Plans for the Project were prepared BOE, Construction Management Division (CMD), completed the construction management of the Project.

BOE has informed RAP that the project is complete and that the contractor has furnished the required permits, drawings, operation and maintenance manuals, warranties and guarantees. The Statement of Completion (SOC) was issued by the Department of Public Works, Bureau of Contract Administration on December 6, 2017.

During the course of construction, eleven (11) change orders were issued for a total amount of \$19,525.84 or 10.1% of the base contract amount, bringing the total construction contract amount of \$212,013.84. The list of change orders is attached to this report for reference. Of the eleven (11) change orders, ten (10) change orders, totaling \$16,889.84, were the result of unforeseen conditions; one (1) change order totaling \$2,636.00, was the result of errors and omissions.

The construction of the project was funded by Proposition K funds. The details of the funding sources utilized for this project were outlined in Report No. 17-011 that was previously approved for the award of the construction contract.

BOE has consulted with the Office of Contract Compliance concerning the status of the labor compliance requirements and Affirmative Action requirements on the Project and Axiom Group is in compliance.

TREES AND SHADE

The project constructed ADA improvements to existing restrooms. No trees were removed for the project, and no shade structures were installed. Trees and shade structures are not part of this phase of the project..

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT

RAP's environmental staff has previously determined that the Project consists of alterations to existing facilities, involving negligible or no expansion of capacity. Therefore, the project was exempted from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article III, Section 1, Class 1 (1, 32) and Class 4 (3), of the CEQA Guidelines

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FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT:

There is no fiscal impact to RAP's General Fund for acceptance of the work for this project in accordance with this Report. However, operational maintenance cost will be determined and a request for funding will be submitted in future RAP's General Fund.
