### SUMMARY

The World Police and Fire Games (WPFG) is an Olympic-style multisport athletic event open to active and retired law enforcement and fire service professionals from around the world. The WPFG, which were first held in 1967, have been held every two years since 1985. The WPFG have been hosted by cities across the globe, and have drawn thousands of participants and spectators from around the world to their host cities.

The City of Los Angeles hosted the 2017 WPFG which took place from August 7, 2017 to August 16, 2017. Fourteen (14) events took place at several RAP Facilities. Various expenses were incurred in the preparation and operation of the WPFG events and the RAP facilities suffered the loss of permit and fee revenue that would have normally been obtained during that period of time. This Report requests that the Board approve the appropriation of the funds from the General City Purposes (GCP) Account into various accounts in order to reimburse RAP for operating expenditures and lost revenue due to the WPFG events.

### FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT

The appropriation of funds will have no negative impact on RAP's General Fund.
