SUMMARY

RAP anticipates additional appropriations needed in Hiring Hall Salaries (Account 1100) and Benefits Hiring Hall (Account 1120) due to shortage of full-time employees, fire watches, extreme weather, as well as other unexpected service and event needs. Although RAP has been working hard and aggressively to hire critically needed full-time employees, the shortage in full-time personnel persists as a result of high rate of retirements, transfers, promotions, etc.
