RECOMMENDATIONS

- Approve the scope of work of the Rio De Los Angeles State Park Outdoor Park Improvements (PRJ21447) (PRJ21462) Project, as described in the Summary of this Report and which was previously approved by the Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners (Board) as part of the application for Proposition 68 Statewide Park Program 2019 Round;
- Authorize Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) staff to commit from the fund and work order numbers detailed in the Attachment to this Report, a maximum of One Million, Nine Hundred Forty Thousand, Six Hundred Four Dollars and Eight Cents (\$1,940,604.08) in Park Fees, for the Rio De Los Angeles State Park – Outdoor Park Improvements (PRJ21447) (PRJ21462) Project;
- 3. Approve the reallocation of Twenty One Thousand, Three Hundred Fifty-Six Dollars and Thirty-Nine Cents (\$21,356.39) in Quimby Fees currently allocated to the Normandie Recreation Center – Path of Travel Improvements (PRJ21127) Project to the Rio De Los Angeles State Park – Outdoor Park Improvements (PRJ21447) (PRJ21462) Project;
- 4. Authorize RAP's Chief Accounting Employee or designee to transfer Twenty-One Thousand, Three Hundred Fifty-Six Dollars and Thirty-Nine Cents (\$21,356.39) in Quimby Fees from the Normandie Recreation Center Account No. 89460K-ND to the Rio De Los Angeles State Park Account No. 89460K-AZ;

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- 5. Authorize RAP's Chief Accounting Employee or designee to transfer Seventy-Six Thousand, One Hundred Twenty-One Dollars and Forty Cents (\$76,121.40) in Quimby Fees from the Quimby Account No. 89460K-00 to the Rio De Los Angeles State Park Account No. 89460K-AZ;
- 6. Approve the allocation of Seventy Six Thousand, One Hundred Twenty-One Dollars and Forty Cents (\$76,121.40) in Quimby Fees from the Rio De Los Angeles State Park Account No. 89460K-AZ to the Rio De Los Angeles State Park – Outdoor Park Improvements (PRJ21447) (PRJ21462) Project; and
- 7. Authorize RAP staff to make technical corrections as necessary to carry out the intent of this Report.

<u>SUMMARY</u>

Rio De Los Angeles State Park is located at 1900 North San Fernando Road in the Northeast community of the City. This 39.39-acre facility provides a children's play area, community room, multipurpose room, picnic tables, tennis courts, baseball diamond (lighted), soccer field, synthetic field, walking paths, and basketball courts. Approximately 4,258 City residents live within a one-half mile walking distance of Rio De Los Angeles State Park. Due to the size of the park, and the facilities and features and programs it provides, Rio De Los Angeles State Park meets the standard for a Community Park, as defined in the City's Public Recreation Plan.

PROJECT SCOPE

In 2019, RAP submitted a grant application for the Rio De Los Angeles State Park – Outdoor Park Improvements (PRJ21447) (PRJ21462) Project for funding under the State's Statewide Park Program (SPP) – 2019 Round (Report Nos. 19-097, 19-165, 19-200). The proposed scope of work for the Rio De Los Angeles State Park – Outdoor Park Improvements (PRJ21447) (PRJ21462) Project included the installation of a new synthetic multipurpose field, replacement of existing turf soccer fields with new synthetic soccer fields, construction of new park lighting and installation of shade structures throughout the park, improvements to the walking paths, picnic and barbeque areas, parking lot and landscaping. The proposed Project is estimated to cost approximately Eight Million, One Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand Dollars (\$8,186,000).

The proposed scope of work for the Project was vetted through an extensive community process, and the Project was strongly supported by local stakeholders. The proposed scope of work for the Project was approved by the Board (Report No. 19-165), and a California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determination for the Project was made by the Board (Report No. 19-200).

In February 2020, the State announced the funding awards for SPP - Round 3 but the Project was not awarded any grant funding.

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Given the high level of local support for the proposed Project, and RAP's desire to implement much needed improvements at this park, RAP Staff is recommending that the Board approves the commitment of available Park Fees and the allocation of Quimby Fees for the proposed Project. While these funds are not sufficient to fully implement the previously approved Project scope, these funds would provide RAP with the opportunity to potentially implement portions of the Project. If a determination is made to implement the Project in phases, RAP would work with stakeholders to identify and prioritize those elements of the Project scope that could potentially be implemented with the available funding.

The Office of Council District 1 is in support of the proposed Project and commitment of Park Fees.

PROJECT FUNDING

Upon approval of this Report, One Million, Nine Hundred Forty Thousand, Six Hundred Four Dollars and Eight Cents (\$1,940,604.08) in Park Fees can be committed to the proposed Project.

Upon approval of this Report, Twenty-One Thousand, Three Hundred Fifty-Six Dollars and Thirty-Nine Cents (\$21,356.39) in Quimby Fees can be transferred from the Normandie Recreation Center 89460K-ND to the Rio De Los Angeles State Park Account No. 89460K-AZ and allocated to the Rio De Los Angeles State Park – Outdoor Park Improvements (PRJ21447) (PRJ21462) Project.

Upon approval of this Report, Seventy-Six Thousand, One Hundred Twenty-One Dollars and Forty Cents (\$76,121.40) in Quimby Fees can be transferred from the Quimby Account No. 89460K-00 to the Rio De Los Angeles State Park Account No. 89460K-AZ and allocated to the Rio De Los Angeles State Park – Outdoor Park Improvements (PRJ21447) (PRJ21462) Project.

The total amount of funding available for the proposed Project is Two Million, Thirty-Eight Thousand, Eighty-One Dollars and Eighty-Seven Cents (\$2,038,081.87).

These Park Fees and Quimby Fees were collected within five (5) miles of Rio De Los Angeles State Park, which is the standard distance for the commitment of Park Fees and Quimby Fees for community recreational facilities pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 12.33 E.3

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PROJECT CONSTRUCTION

The proposed Project is estimated to cost approximately Eight Million, One Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand Dollars (\$8,186,000).

As previously noted, the available Park Fees and Quimby Fees are not sufficient to fully implement the previously approved Project scope. However, RAP will work with various stakeholders, including local elected officials, to try to identify and secure the supplemental funding necessary to complete the proposed Project.

It is currently unknown when construction of the Project will begin.

TREES AND SHADE

This proposed Project will have no impact on the existing trees at Rio De Los Angeles State Park. The number of new shades structures has yet to be determined.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

On October 2, 2019 (Report No. 19-200), the Board found that the proposed Project is exempt from the provisions of CEQA. The scope of work of the proposed Project has not changed from that previously approved by the Board as part of the Proposition 68 SPP 2019 Round applications. Should new information about the project and the potential impacts become available, additional environmental CEQA issues will be addressed as project designs are brought back for the Board's consideration.

FISCAL IMPACT

The approval of this commitment of Park Fees and allocation of Quimby Fees will have no fiscal impact on RAP's General Fund.

The estimated costs for the design, development, and construction of the proposed park improvements are anticipated to be funded by Park Fees and Quimby Fees or funding sources other than the RAP's General Fund. The maintenance of the proposed park improvements can be performed by current staff with minimal impact to existing maintenance service at this facility.
