RECOMMENDATION:

DOADD DEDODT

Accept a donation of a horse "Gryffin" for the Park Ranger Division Mounted Unit and direct that appropriate recognition be given to the donor.

SUMMARY:

The Park Ranger Division Mounted Unit (Division) is responsible for patrolling park trails, conducting presentations for interpretive programs and representing the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) at various events. Well-trained horses that will remain calm in various interactions with the public are required for this job. Jessica Gibson, a private citizen, has graciously offered to donate her horse, "Gryffin", to RAP for use by the Division. "Gryffin" is a 12-year-old Appaloosa gelding that is of good health and temperament and would be well suited to the work of the Division.

Accepting this donation would allow the Division to keep up its current stable of four sound horses, as another of our horses has reached the end of his serviceability and is due to be retired from service soon.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Accepting this donation, with an estimated value of Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000), will save RAP the cost of purchasing another horse to replace the horse that is due for retirement. All care and feeding costs will be transferred from the retired horse to this horse, resulting in no additional impact to RAP's General Fund.
