RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Retroactively approve the time extension of the Proposition A grant performance period from December 31, 2021 to August 31, 2023 for the Alpine Recreation Center Expansion Project with respect to the Proposition A grant agreement to develop the Alpine Recreation Center Expansion Project (also known as Ord and Yale Street Park) (Alpine Project);
- 2. Retroactively approve the time extension of the Proposition A grant performance period from January 13, 2022 to February 28, 2025 for the Rancho Cienega Sports Complex (Celes King III) Project (Rancho Project); and
- 3. Retroactively approve the Department of Recreation and Park's (RAP) General Manager's execution of the amendments to the Alpine Project and the Rancho Project regarding the time extensions described in this Report as attached to this Report as Attachment 1 and Attachment 2, subject to City Council approval and approval as to form by the City Attorney.

SUMMARY

Through the Los Angeles County Safe Neighborhood Parks, Gang Prevention, Tree Planting, Senior and Youth Recreation, Beaches and Wildlife Protection Act of 1992 (Proposition A-I) and the Los Angeles County Park, Beach and Recreation Act of 1996 (Proposition A-II), the City of

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Los Angeles was awarded competitive, discretionary, and specified grant funds to be administered by RAP for various park projects.

One of the awarded projects is the Alpine Recreation Center Expansion. Located at 524 Ord Street, Los Angeles, the Alpine Project scope involves the creation of a new park on a vacant blighted hillside as an extension to the Alpine Recreation Center. New park amenities include benches, planting of new trees, park lighting, a raised platform, a shade structure, ramps, stairs, walkways, viewing terraces, a restroom facility, drinking fountains, fitness equipment, play structures, cultural artwork, installation of interpretive graphics and signage, and related irrigation and landscaping. To date, the Alpine Project has been awarded Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand, Nine Hundred Sixty-Six Dollars and Fifty-Nine Cents (\$950,966.59) in Proposition A funds.

The Rancho Cienega Sports Complex (Celes King III) Project is located at 5001 Obama Blvd., Los Angeles, CA 90016 (formerly Rodeo Rd.). The grant scope of work for the Rancho Project is: Design and construct a new Sports Complex facility which will include a new gym, pool bathhouse, fitness annex, and community room. The southern portion of the park will also include new lighting, landscaping improvements, and storm water. The Proposition A grant award is Forty-Four Thousand, Seven Hundred Eighty-Six Dollars and Sixty-One Cents (\$44,786.61).

RAP would like to extend the Proposition A grant performance period for the Alpine Project from December 31, 2021 to August 31, 2023; and the Rancho Project from January 13, 2022 to February 28, 2025. This additional time is necessary to complete construction and post construction activities that were delayed in order to adhere to precautionary public safety guidelines set forth by the city and state in response to the COVID-19 Pandemic. The grant performance time extensions will enable RAP to conduct post-construction administrative close out of the Proposition A grants such as assembling close out package materials and reconciling all remaining invoices.

RAP staff submitted requests to extend the performance period for the Alpine Project on September 16, 2021 and the Rancho Project on September 13, 2021. However, the Los Angeles County Regional Park and Open Space District, who is the grantor for the Proposition A grant, did not send the applicable grant amendments extending the performance periods for the Alpine Project until December 8, 2021 and the Rancho Project until November 24, 2021. Due to the necessity to execute the grant amendments prior to the expiration of the prior performance periods for both projects, staff was required to execute and submit the grant amendments attached hereto as Attachment 1 and Attachment 2 (Grant Amendments) prior to submitting them to the Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners (Board) for approval. Through this Report, staff requests the Board's retroactive approval of the Grant Amendments and their execution by RAP's General Manager.

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TREES AND SHADE

The performance period extensions provided under the Grant Amendments will not have any impact on any existing plan with respect to trees and shade structures at Alpine Recreation Center Expansion site or Rancho Cienega Sports Complex (Celes King III).

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

The Alpine Recreation Center Expansion Project is in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requirements. The appropriate CEQA documentations have been previously approved by the Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners (Report No. 17-248, December 13, 2017). A Notice of Exemption (NOE) was filed with the Los Angeles County Clerk on May 4, 2017, and the Los Angeles City Clerk on May 5, 2017. No further determination is required at this time.

The Rancho Cienega Sports Complex (Celes King III) Project has been previously evaluated and approved in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). A Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) was certified, and a Statement of Overriding Considerations and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Plan was adopted by the Board, on December 14, 2016 (Report No. 16-250). A Notice of Determination was filed with the Los Angeles County Clerk on December 15, 2016. No further determination is required at this time.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no expected fiscal impact to RAP's General Fund for the extension of the grant performance period for the projects.

The parties agree that the electronic signatures appearing on this agreement and any subsequent amendments are the same as handwritten signatures for the purposes of validity, enforceability, and admissibility. If Grantee elects to opt-out of signing the Agreement electronically, the Grantee must inform the District in writing prior to Agreement execution.
