RECOMMENDATION:

BOARD REPORT

Accept a donation of a horse "El Commando (Archie)" for the Park Ranger Division Mounted Unit.

SUMMARY:

The Park Ranger Division Mounted Unit (Division) is responsible for patrolling park trails, conducting presentations for interpretive programs and representing the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) at various events. Well-trained horses that will remain calm in various interactions with the public are required for this job. The Griffith J. Griffith Trust and the Los Angeles Parks Foundation has offered to donate the horse, "El Commando (Archie)", to RAP for use by the Division. The horse is a nine-year-old American Quarter Horse gelding, valued at \$10, 250. After a one month evaluation period and veterinary check, staff has found "El Commando (Archie)" to be of good health and temperament and believes he would be well suited to the work of the Division.

Accepting this donation would bring the Division closer to its goal of having four serviceable horses, as two of its horses have recently been retired from service.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Accepting this donation, with an estimated value of Ten Thousand, Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$10,250), will save RAP the cost of purchasing another horse to replace the horse that has been retired. All care and feeding costs will be transferred from the retired horse to this horse, resulting in no additional impact to RAP's General Fund.
