RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Approve the time extension of the Measure A Grant Program (Measure A) grant performance period as set forth in this Report for the following projects (Time Extensions), subject to review and approval by the Los Angeles County Regional Park and Open Space District (Grantor): Alvarado Terrace Park Playground Replacement Project and Del Rey Lagoon Playground Replacement Project (collectively, Projects).
- 2. Authorize the Department of Recreation and Park's (RAP) General Manager to execute amendments to the Measure A grant agreements for the Projects in substantially the same form as set forth in Attachment 1 of this Report for the Time Extensions upon approval by Grantor, and subject to City Council approval and approval as to form by the City Attorney.

<u>SUMMARY</u>

RAP Staff requests time extensions of the grant performance period end date for two Measure A projects.

ALVARADO TERRACE PARK PLAYGROUND REPLACEMENT

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For Alvarado Terrace Park Playground Replacement project, RAP is requesting extension of the Measure A performance period end date from July 15, 2022 to July 17, 2023. At this time, the project construction is complete and the park is open to the public. The time extension will enable RAP to complete and satisfy the administrative close out of the grant under the Measure A grant guidelines which were revised on January 2022. The Grantor has recommended that RAP extend the performance end date to provide sufficient time for close out.

The Alvarado Terrace Park Playground Replacement project (CD1) is located at 1342 S. Alvarado Terrace, Los Angeles, CA 90006. The Measure A grant scope of work is: Demolition and removal of existing play area, installation of new play area and safety surfacing, site landscaping and other amenities, park pathway and path of travel improvements. The Measure A grant award is Five Hundred Forty Thousand, Nine Hundred Dollars (\$540,900).

DEL REY LAGOON PLAYGROUND REPLACEMENT

For Del Rey Lagoon Playground Replacement project, RAP is requesting extension of the Measure A performance period end date from July 15, 2022 to July 17, 2023. At this time, the project construction is complete and the park is open to the public. The time extension will enable RAP to complete and satisfy the administrative close out of the grant under the Measure A grant guidelines which were revised on January 2022.

Del Rey Lagoon Playground Replacement Project (CD11) is located at 6660 Esplanade Place, Playa Del Rey, CA 90293. The Measure A grant scope of work is: Demolition and removal of existing play area, installation of new play area and safety surfacing, site landscaping and other amenities, park pathway and path of travel improvements. The grant award is Four Hundred Sixty Seven Thousand, Eight Hundred Dollars (\$467,800).

RAP received the grant awards for these Projects in June 2020. The grants were part of the first round of 15 awards which RAP applied for and received under Measure A's formula-based Categories 1 and 2 Annual Allocation Program. On February 6, 2020, the Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners (Board) authorized the submission of 15 capital improvement project applications for Measure A funds and acceptance of the grant funds upon award (Report No. 20-026). The Los Angeles City Council authorized the submission of the Measure A grant applications and RAP to accept the awarded grant funds on April 22, 2020 (C.F. No. 20-0278).

TREES AND SHADE

The Measure A performance period extensions for the Projects will not have any impact on any existing plans with respect to trees and shade structures.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

The Projects are in compliance with California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requirements. The Notices of Exemption (NOE) for Alvarado Terrace Park Playground Replacement Project

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and Del Rey Lagoon Playground Replacement Project were filed with the Los Angeles County Clerk on August 11, 2020.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no expected fiscal impact to RAP's General Fund for the extension of the grant performance period for the Projects.

Approval of this Board Report advances RAP's strategic plan by supporting:

Goal No. 1: Provide Safe and Accessible Parks

Outcome No. 2: All parks are safe and welcoming
