SUMMARY

Management of the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) has identified the need for a Senior Park Services Attendant to act as a liaison between the Greek Theatre and RAP to address common issues and concerns, and requests the Board of Recreation and Parks Commissioners (Board) establish a position of Senior Park Services Attendant, Code 2422, in special funded authority.

This Report has been reviewed by staff of the Office of the City Administrative Officer.

FISCAL IMPACT

The top annual salary of a Senior Park Services Attendant according to "City Pay" is currently Seventy-Five Thousand, One Hundred Eighty-Eight Dollars and Eighty-Eight Cents (\$75,188.88).
